



# Safety Recall Notice

HP is conducting a worldwide voluntary recall of certain battery packs shipped in notebook PCs manufactured between December 2004 and June 2006. The batteries can overheat, posing a fire and burn hazard to consumers. Battery packs that may be part of this recall program have a bar-code label that starts with either L0, L1, A0 or GC.



## What to do:

1. Immediately stop using your battery pack.
